

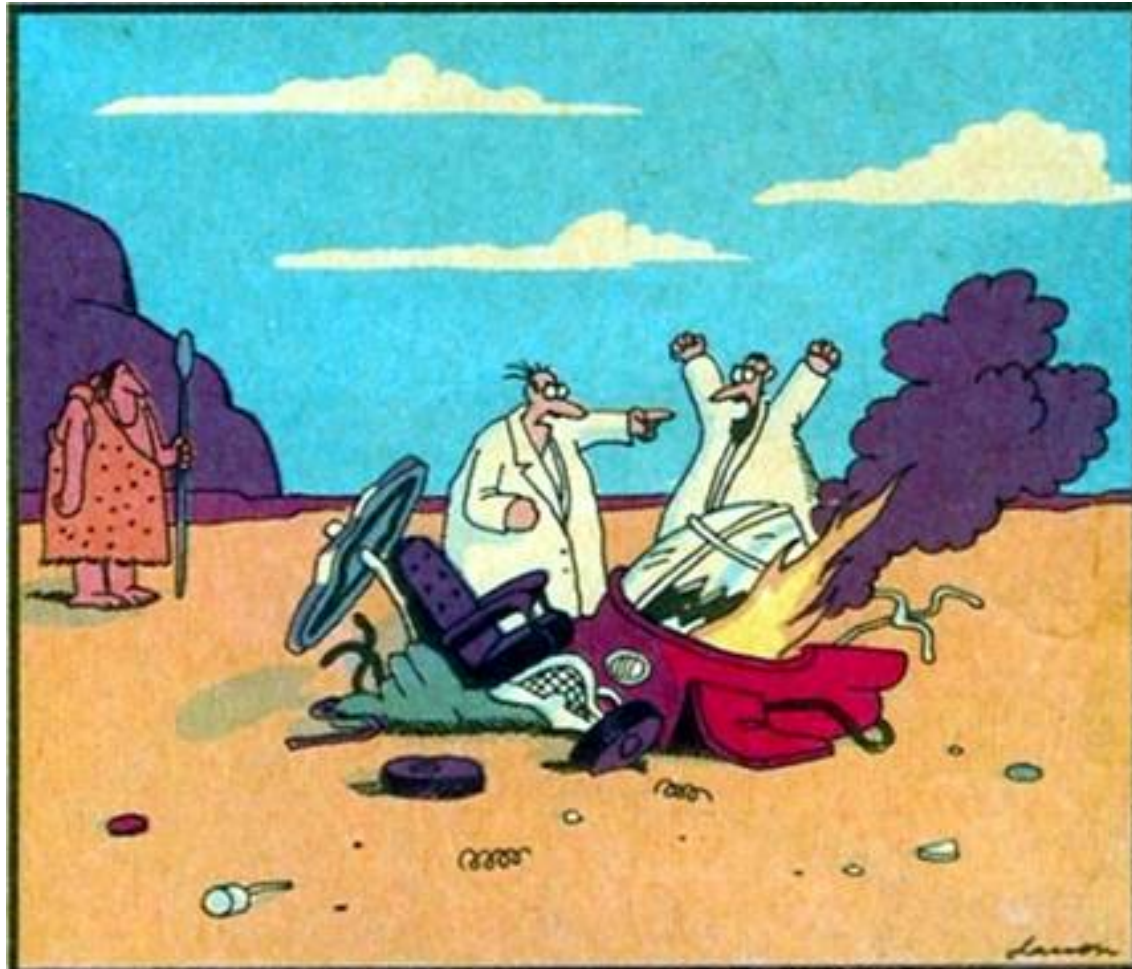

the Doorknob Principle.



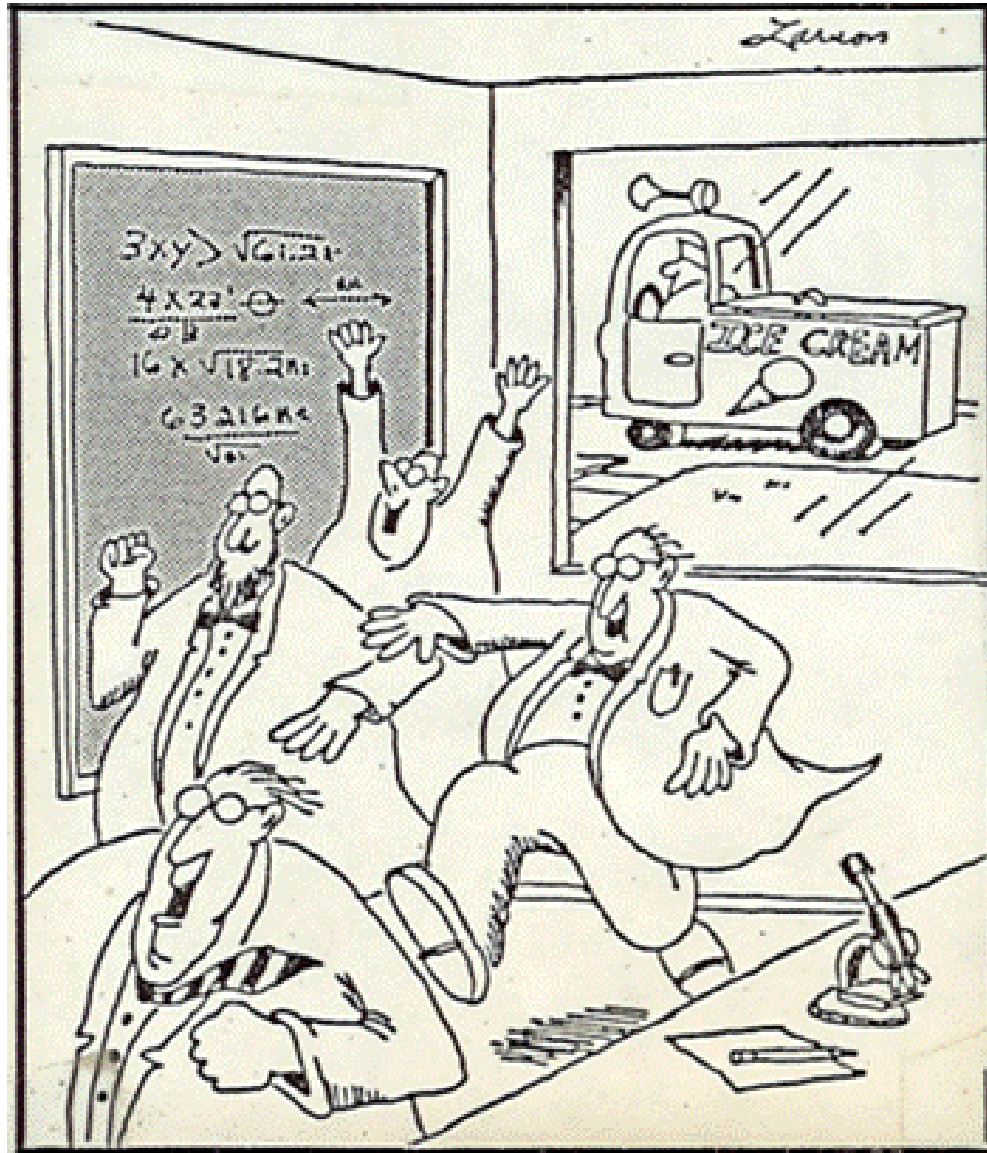
"Notice all the computations, theoretical scribbles and lab

"And I've only one thing to say about all these complaints I've been hearing about . . . venison!"



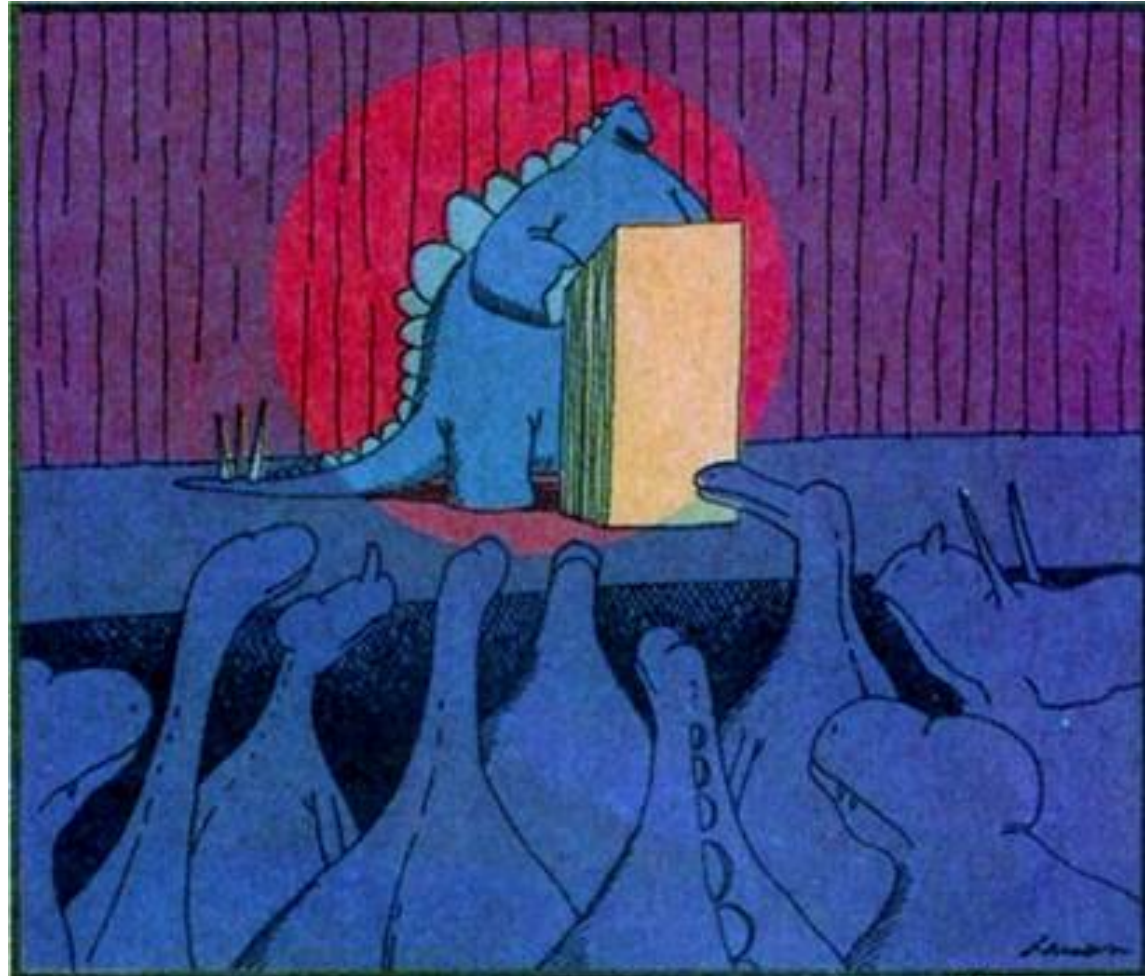
